County & District Councillor Alison Thomas provided a verbal report the main points of which were:

District Council Matters

SNC is to declare it has met its 5 year land supply and that she agreed with the Parish Council that existing allocated sites for new housing should be built out before new sites are allowed to be developed.

County Council Matters

Children's services Ofsted report has moved from special measures to the requiring improvement category with some areas nudging towards good. The fostering services have also received a national exemplar award.

The Norwich Distributor Road will be opening fully on the 12th April.

The Hempnall crossroads is to become a roundabout.

The duelling of the A47 is being sought.

She has been working with Dr Harris at Long Stratton High School and supports his positive attitude to turning the school around.
