Following the purchase of a new Speed Activated Machine (SAM) for use in the TAS Valley, South Norfolk District Council is seeking suggestions for where you would like to deploy the machine in your Hempnall.

The machine will be lent to successful bidders for two weeks at a time. Please bear this in mind when considering your availability to operate the machine. A risk assessment will also be carried out nearer the time by the Police Road Safety Team to determine the suitability of locations you suggest in terms of safety.



If you are interested please can you provide the clerk with the following:

1. A plan/map showing where you would like to deploy/position the machine.
2. Contact details of volunteers who will be operating the machine.
3. Details of a secure location where the machine will be stored over night.

Training on how to operate and deploy SAM will be provided.
