### Oil Bulk Buying Scheme – Save£ Save£ Save£



Many people who do not have gas and rely on expensive oil for heating would like to start a fuel bulk-buying scheme in Hempnall to take advantage of cheaper prices.

#### Interested?

As a member of the scheme you would be able to take advantage of low prices from bulk buying for schemes covering all of Norfolk via links with other Norfolk Rural Community Council schemes.

- You would be able to order as much or as little as you like.
- Order when and as often as you like (at the start of each month).
- If you find oil cheaper elsewhere, there is no obligation to buy through the scheme.

To find out more there will be a meeting at **The Mill Centre, Hempnall at 7.30pm 28 May 2013** to explain how the scheme would work and answer any questions.

### Parish Poll Result

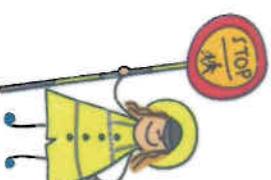
The Parish Poll was taken on the 18th March on the following matter:

“Do you support the planning application (SNC Ref 2013/0105) by Streetwood Wind Farm Norfolk Limited (Agent’s name: TCI Renewables Limited) for the erection of 4 wind turbines in Hempnall?” and on the voting slip there could be two options: “YES /NO”

The result of the parish poll was 100 Yes and 422 No and 7 spoil papers. This represents a strong turnout of 50.47% which is considerably higher than the average turnout of 33% calculated by the clerk from other parish polls held across the country in the last 3 years. Thus 80.84% of valid votes were No and 19.16% Yes. Thank you to all those that voted, especially on such a cold evening.

### Parish Council backs School Road Safety Measures

We are pleased to have been able to submit a recent application to Norfolk County Council for increased road safety measures around Hempnall School. Well done to all the school supporters who put so much work into this project and for raising the £31,000 funds required.
