Parish Poll – Vote on revised Wind Turbine Application

Even if you voted in the last parish poll you will need to vote again if your views are to be counted, as this application is for a different number of turbines.

At the parish meeting held in September, parishioners requested that the parish council arrange a Parish Poll. **This is an official vote, which will be recognised by the planning authorities.**

South Norfolk District Council will advertise the Parish Poll for the **21st October 2013 between 4pm and 9pm.** The polling station will be The Mill Centre, Mill Rd, Hempnall – If you are on the electoral roll, put this date in your **Diary Now**, there will be no postal or proxy votes or poll cards, you need to be there to make your vote count.

The question you will be asked to vote on is: “Do you support the planning application (SNC Ref 2013/0105 as amended) by Streetwood Wind Farm, Norfolk Limited (Agent’s name: TCI Renewables Limited) for the erection of 3 wind turbines in Hempnall ?” Answer - Yes/No.

It is extremely important to take this opportunity to vote as the strength of feeling shown by parishioners will be an important factor in how both the parish and district council responds to the planning consultation.
